  - (a) read 10 of the twenty-five books on the list. Books include fiction, nonfiction, and picture books across a range of reading levels; and,
  - (b) complete a reading response. Examples include a brief book review, a postcard, a letter to the author, or the design of a new book cover.
- Over the summer, students who get started on this reading list may send reading responses to Ms. Hines. Each student has received a postage-paid, pre-addressed postcard they can complete and mail to Ms. Hines.
